Time Leaving: 04H00 Sunday
(Leaving from Crows Nest) and
returning scout time 17H00.

Cost: R 300.00 (covering petrol
and food for Saturday and Sunday.

Notes: Consent forms, copy of
records and R 100.00 deposit
handed in by 14/05/2010. Balance
of payment by the 04/06/2010.

Rucksacks must be dropped off at
Crows Nest between 15H00 and
18H00 on the 12/06/2010.

Survival bash is for all scouts no
matter what age you are. Younger
scouts will do the Veldcraft Badge
and other Scoutcraft Badges. Check
with Crow which skills track you will
be on - Backwoodsman or Veldcraft.

Phongola is in a MALARIA AREA so
please consult the chemist 14 days
before we go. We will have lots of
ticks so ask for something for those
little bugs.

Scouts doing Backwoodsman chicken
must hand in an extra R 35.00. This
is only for scouts with the Veldcraft
Badge or 14 years old.

All food must fit into a ? container,
TBA at the first prep meeting held
on the 18/05/2010 that all must
attend.

Survival kit: Signaling mirror,
fishing hocks and line, safety pin,
salt, thin wire, space blanket, black
bag, candle, wire saw, whistle,
spare laces, spare batteries and
globe, pencil, paper, magnifying
glass/flint and steel, pocket knife,
needle and thread, water
purification tablets.

Hot chocolate (2 spoons)
